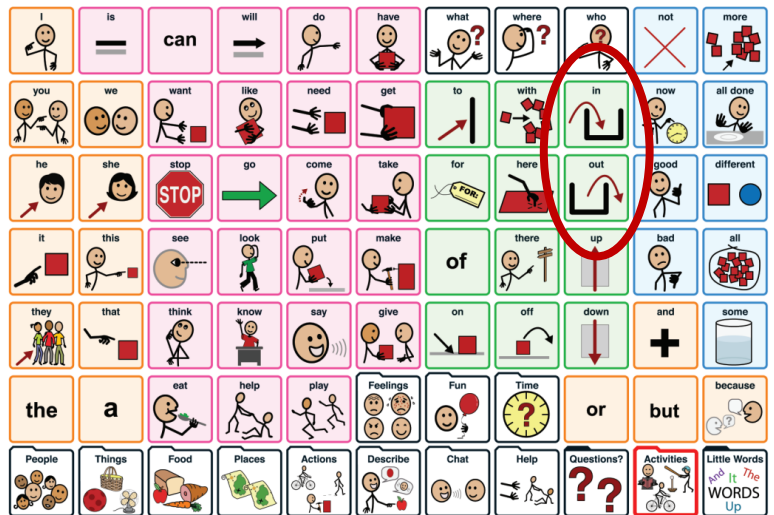

My name is Helena and I am the School Speech Pathologist, on site on a Friday.

This Term we have been continuing to follow the core word of the week program, modelling words using key word sign and picture communication. This weeks Core Words of the Week are 'In & Out'.



In C2, we have been working on developing our social and play skills within structured turn taking games such as Pop Up Pirate, Pop the Pig and the Beetle Game. This Term, we have progressed to games which require strategy, more critical thinking and active and ongoing engagement whilst continuing to facilitate independence with turn taking and social communication, through playing games such as Jenga and Trouble.

## WE ARE MOVING TO COMPASS



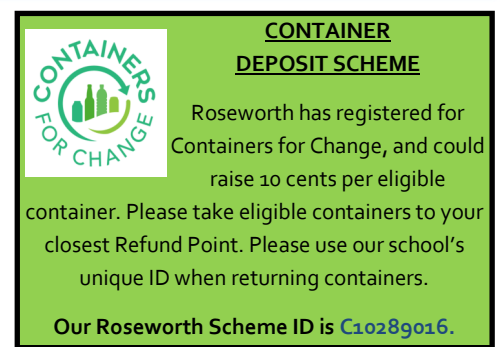
We're excited to announce that Roseworth Education Support Centre is transitioning to the Compass platform.
