Speech Pathology Update – March 2026

Welcome to the first newsletter for the year. I'm looking forward to working with students, staff, and families to support communication, language, and learning across the school.

To start the year, I would like to share an important update from the Australian Government regarding **increased access to Medicare-funded speech pathology services**.

Medicare Update: Increased Access to Speech Pathology

From **1 March 2026**, access to **Medicare-rebated speech pathology services** has expanded for children and young people.

This change aims to improve **early access to speech therapy and communication support**.

Who is eligible?

Children and young people may now be eligible if they:

- Are **under 25 years of age**
- Are **suspected of or diagnosed with an eligible condition** listed under the expanded **Medicare M10 list**
- Receive a **referral from a GP or medical specialist**

Conditions included in the expanded list

The expanded list now includes:

- **Stuttering**
- **Speech sound disorders** (difficulty producing speech sounds clearly)
- **Cleft lip and/or palate**

What support is available?

Eligible children and young people may receive **Medicare rebates** for:

- Up to **8 assessment sessions**
- Up to **20 therapy sessions**

These services can be provided by **qualified speech pathologists**.

If you have concerns

If you have concerns about your child's **speech, language, or communication development**, you can:

- Speak with your **GP about a referral**
- Contact a **speech pathologist for further advice**

Early support can make a significant difference to children's **communication, learning, and confidence**.
