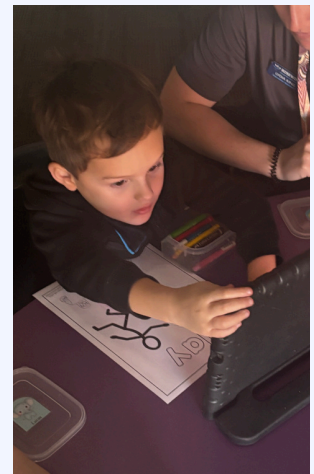
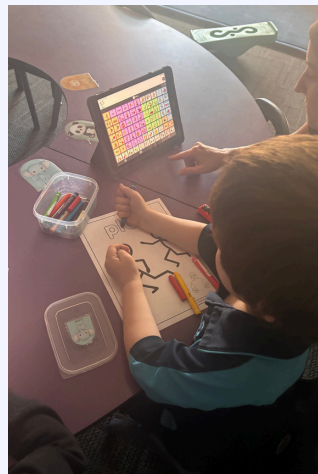


C1
