Speech Pathology Update

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a fantastic term so far, and we wanted to share some of the wonderful learning happening across our classrooms!

Our students and staff have been working exceptionally hard with the UFLI (University of Florida Literacy Initiative) Foundations program. The dedication from our learners has been inspiring, and best of all, the kids are absolutely loving it! We are seeing huge boosts in reading confidence, phonics skills, and enthusiasm for literacy every single day.

To make sure every student can engage fully and express themselves, our teaching team has been incorporating Key Word Sign alongside tailored visual supports across daily routines.

We are also using interactive visual tools that allow students to directly manipulate, touch, and engage with words and concepts. These hands-on, multi-sensory experiences help bridge communication gaps and make learning both accessible and deeply interactive for all our learners.

How You Can Help at Home:

Celebrate the wins: Ask your child about the sound or word patterns they practiced today.

Use visuals: Encouraging your child to point to pictures or use simple signs at home reinforces what they learn at school.
